Full Time Attendance The Department of Public and One Health aims at taking part in the research and training for the assessment of health needs, the implementation of measures to improve health and environmental protection, the utilization of health services and the evaluation of effectiveness of interventions. The interdisciplinary view of human, animal and environmental health is an innovative approach that ranks the Department of Public and One Health at the forefront of science internationally. The duration of studies in the Department of Public and One Health last four academic years (eight semesters). Studies include lectures, workshops, seminars, business simulations and work-based learning. Special emphasis is given to team working skills development, extensive participation in case-study assignments. Graduation requires successful attendance and examination in 46 courses (39 core, 7 optional) with internship and dissertation, corresponding to a total of 240 ECTS credits.

8. **INFORMATION ON THE NATIONAL HIGHER EDUCATION SYSTEM (i) Structure**

According to the Greek Constitution (article 16), higher education is public. It is provided only by institutions which are legal entities of public law. HEIs enjoy full self-administration and academic freedom. They are subject to state supervision. The government finances them. No private HEIs exist in the country. Admission of students has to do with their performance in the national Pan-Hellenic exams at the end of grade C of lykeio (upper secondary school).

More specifically:

The <u>Hellenic Open University</u> is an independent and fully self-governed HEI in the form of legal entity of public law. Its seat is in Patras. Its mission is to provide high-quality university education via distance learning at both undergraduate and postgraduate level. <u>Law 2552/1997</u> regulates its operation.

The <u>International Hellenic University</u> is an independent and fully self-governed HEI. It has registered offices in Thessaloniki. It operates as an academic unit of the institution called "University Centre of International Programmes Studies", stipulated by <u>law 4610/2019</u> with the aim to provide higher education in a foreign language to Greeks and foreigners.

In 2002, the technological sector merged the School of Pedagogical and Technological Education (ASPETE). It was established in Athens to substitute the former School of Vocational and Technical Teacher Training Institute (SELETE). It includes 3 departments of engineering educators of various specializations. It offers technological excellence to graduates. It also has a pedagogical department. Its mission is to provide knowledge to undergraduates in the field of humanities and science studies.

Law 4521/2018 established the University of West Attica. It is the merger of two technological educational institutes:

- TEI of Piraeus
- TEI of Athens.

In addition, law 4559/2018 introduced two more mergers:

1. The merger of the TEI of Epirus with the University of Ioannina

2. The merger of the TEI of Ionian Islands with the Ionian University. According to <u>law</u> <u>4610/2019</u>:

1. The International Hellenic University has merged with:

- The TEI of Thessaloniki
- The TEI of Central Macedonia
- The TEI of Eastern Macedonia and Thrace.
- 2. The University of Western Macedonia has merged with the TEI of Western Macedonia
- 3. The Greek Mediterranean University has been established and has merged the TEI of Crete
- 4. The University of Patras has merged the TEI of Western Greece (except for 4 departments)
- 5. The University of the Peloponnese has merged the TEI of Peloponnese and 4 departments of the TEI of Western Greece
- 6. The University of West Attica has merged the National School of Public Health (ESDY).

According to <u>law 4589/2019</u>, the following are being completed:

- The merge of University of Thessaly and the TEI of Thessaly
- The merge of the TEI of Central Greece with the University of Athens, the University of Thessaly and the Agricultural University of Athens (Geoponiko Panepistimio Athinon).

(ii) Access

Entrance to the various Schools of the **Universities** (*Panepistimio*) depends on the general score obtained by Lyceum graduates on the Certificate, on the number of available places (*numerus clauses*) and on the candidates' ranked preferences among schools and sections. (iii) **Qualifications**

Students who successfully complete their studies in universities I are awarded a *Ptychio* (first cycle degree). First cycle programmes last from four years for most fields to five years for engineering and certain other applied science fields and six years for medicine. The *Ptychio* leads to employment or further study at the post-graduate level that includes the one year second cycle leading to the second degree, *Diploma Metaptychiakon Spoudon* - equivalent to the *Master's* degree - and the third cycle leading to the doctorate degree, *Didaktoriko Diploma*.

Legislation on quality assurance in Higher Education, the Credit Transfer System and the Diploma Supplement defines the framework and criteria for evaluation of university departments and for certification of student degrees. These measures aim at promoting student mobility and contributing to the creation of a European Higher Education Area.
